Open Day Felting Workshop on Saturday 17th October 2026

This is a workshop aimed at the complete beginner who would like to take home a finished product. Using some of the wool from your own flock, or we are happy to provide some if you give us notice. It will be a fun day to learn the basics so you can go on to make your felted project, or a peg loomed seat cushion, or say never again, knowing that you have given it your best shot!!

We will be working in Jacob wool. For felting it will need to be washed and carded. It's a wet process so please bring an apron and washing up gloves. For peg looming wool does not need any prior preparation. We are able to provide a number of peg looms to share, but if you have a peg loom of your own, please bring it along.

We can cater for a maximum of 15 people, so please book early. We welcome non-members accompanied by a member and children accompanied by an adult.

Remember: Please bring

- A packed lunch
- A few handfuls of your own washed and carded wool (500g) for a felted bowl and a carrier bag full of raw wool that can be washed or unwashed for the peg looming or let us know you need some providing.
- An apron
- Washing up gloves
- Peg loom, if you have one, with some available to buy or borrow on the day.

Plan for the day.

- 10.00am Tea/Coffee
- 10.15am Introduction and demonstration on how felting and peg looming works. Then split into 2 groups for felted bowls or peg looming.

- ☐ 10.30am One group to loom and one to felt with a switch around after lunch if you would like a go at both
- ☐ 12.30pm Break for lunch
- ☐ 1.00pm Continue with the mornings project or switch
- ☐ 3.00pm Tea / Coffee & Cake with a Q&A session
- ☐ 4.00 pm Finish
