CONDITIONS OF ENTRY & RULES

The Sale will be conducted in accordance with the rules for Shows and

We would like to draw your attention to the following: New byelaws applicable this year:

8(p) All rams of one year or older must be kept on a halter at all times in the show ring.

9(m) Any sheep which is unsalable, i.e. not tagged correctly or rejected for welfare issues, should be removed from the market at which point the matter is deemed to be out of the Society's hands.

9(n) the description in the catalogue of Flock Dispersal will mean that the whole of the pedigree flock of that member is sold and that the flock will no longer exist. Any dispersal sale of sheep will be held at the end of the sale and they will not be inspected.

9(o) Only one handler per sheep to be allowed in the show ring at official shows and sales.

9(p) The Jacob Sheep Society, its officers, trustees and servants, shall not be held responsible for any accident, damage or loss however caused. Anyone attending a sale or other event held by or on behalf of the Jacob Sheep Society shall indemnify the Society from and against all actions, suits, expenses and claims on account of or in respect of any such damage or injury which may be so caused.

*Rejected sheep will not be sold at any time at Official Sales. Please note **Substituted** sheep will now have white tape on their horn and **Rejected** sheep will have red tape.*

*Any sheep that is tested for Tay Sachs **MUST** have its status, i.e. clear or carrier, declared in the catalogue at Official Show & Sales.*

The catalogue will be produced directly from the Grassroots Database. If your sheep is not registered before the deadline it cannot be accepted in the sale.

General Information

Sheep to be penned by 8am at the latest, for inspection. Pedigree & Scrapie Certificates to be handed in at the time of inspection to JSS Stewards.

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
